(The Resolution of 4/11/2011, currently in force, reads as follows: "When one Member of the Board communicates with another about Board business, the email should be copied to the entire board with one of two texts in the heading: MUST READ or DELETE IF NOT INTERESTED IN \_\_\_\_ (subject).")
